

Proyecta 100,000 - Request for Proposals 2016

In May 2013, President Barack Obama and President Enrique Peña Nieto announced the U.S.-Mexico Bilateral Forum on Higher Education, Innovation and Research (FOBESII) to expand opportunities for educational exchanges, scientific research partnerships, and cross-border innovation. The official launching of FOBESII took place on May 21st, 2014, during the visit of U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry to Mexico City.

FOBESII is consistent with both President Obama's 100,000 Strong in the Americas initiative, and Mexico's *Proyecta 100,000* program that aims to achieve the mobility of 100,000 Mexican students, teachers and researchers to the United States by 2018, and to host 50,000 US students in Mexico by the same year.

If your institution is interested in hosting Mexican undergraduate students and teachers supported by scholarships from the Mexican Government in 2016, please submit proposals for the following modalities:

English as a Second Language Courses (Spring, Summer and Fall 2016)

The participants of the English as a Second Language courses will be undergraduate students, teachers and researchers. The cost of the course must not exceed US\$3,500.00 per learner and it should have a length of 4 weeks and include 96 hours of academic lessons. It must include tuition costs, educational fees, housing, a comprehensive meal program, medical insurance, ground transportation from/to the nearest airport and all other student services or costs (books, course materials, etc.). *Proyecta 100,000* will prioritize those proposals with the best economical offers limited to US\$3,500.00.

English Teacher Training Courses (Spring, Summer and Fall 2016)

The participants of the English Teacher Training Courses will be teachers from K-12 and higher education institutions. The cost of the course must not exceed US\$4,500.00 per learner and it should cover a training program of English language teaching for Spanish-speakers, with at least 96 academic hours during 4 weeks. It must include tuition fees, educational fees, housing, a comprehensive meal program, medical insurance, ground transportation from/to the nearest airport and all other student services or costs (books, course materials, etc). Proyecta 100,000 will prioritize those proposals with the best economical offers limited to US\$4,500.00.
